Dr Purvi Mehta, Senior Advisor, Global Centre of Adaptation Visited TAAS

New Delhi, October 28, 2025 — The Trust for Advancement of Agricultural Sciences (TAAS) hosted Dr Purvi

Mehta, Senior Advisor at the Global Centre on Adaptation.

TAAS Chairman Dr R.S. Paroda welcomed Dr Mehta and introduced her to the staff, providing a brief history of TAAS's establishment and purpose of Global Conference on Women in Agri-Food Systems (GCWAS-2026). Dr Bhag Mal detailed the organization's objectives, structure, activities, its policy impact on Indian agriculture.
